Those wishing to enter Bosnia and Herzegovina must have one of the following:

- 1) a negative COVID-19 test (PCR or antigen) not older than 48 hours if coming from Europe and not older than 72 hours if arriving from other countries;
- 2) or a COVID-19 vaccination certificate showing full vaccination completed 10 days prior to arrival;
- 3) or a doctor's certificate of COVID-19 recovery in the period 10 to 180 days prior to arrival.
- 4) Children until the age of seven, accompanied by a parent who meets the above conditions may enter without a COVID-19 test or certificate.
- 5) Foreign nationals who are permanently or temporarily resident in Bosnia and Herzegovina may enter without a COVID-19 test or certificate if returning from Croatia, Montenegro or Serbia with stays in those countries for less than 48 hours.
- 6) Citizens of Croatia, Montenegro or Serbia may enter without a COVID-19 test or certificate when coming directly from those countries.
